Occupational Profile

Bakers may work in a craft bakery, plant bakery or retail outlet. A craft baker works in a production unit producing hand crafted bakery products. They supply their own retail outlets or sell direct to third party wholesale customers. A plant baker produces bakery products using large scale production methods, to supply food and retail outlets. They work in a large-scale production facility, with a high level of automation in a continuous process. A retail baker is involved in both production and shop floor activities. They produce, bake off and display products for direct sale to customers.

Grading

The standard is graded overall: Fail, Pass, Merit or Distinction.

End Point Assessment

Multiple-choice Test

A 40-question multiple-choice question test taken online. The test will have a maximum duration of 60 minutes and is awarded a fail or pass grade.

Observation

The observation should take place in the apprentice's workplace and will be for a duration of 4.5 hours including questions. Core and optional K.S.Bs related to this assessment method will be observed during this time. The observation is awarded fail, pass, merit or distinction.

Interview underpinned by a Portfolio of Evidence

The interview duration is for 45 minutes with up to 10% to allow the apprentice to complete their last answer. Apprentices can refer to and illustrate their answers with evidence from their portfolio of evidence, however the portfolio evidence is not directly assessed. The interview is awarded a fail or pass grade.
