Occupational Profile

Boatbuilders build boats such as yachts, workboats and superyachts and/or refit and repair existing boats. Boats may be made of composites, metals or wood so a boatbuilder can work with and understand the capabilities of a variety of materials. They can read and interpret engineering and technical drawings to produce moulds, jigs, plugs and templates to create complex shapes using a variety of measuring equipment, machines and hand tools.

Grading

The standard is graded overall: Fail, Pass.

End Point Assessment

Work based Project

The apprentice will be required to complete a work-based project during the last 3-6 months of their apprenticeship. work-based projects reflect the operational activities of the business and allow competence to be demonstrated across the boatbuilder standard. Apprentices will be required to use research, investigation and problem-solving skills as well as practical skills to achieve a specific project goal. The project will be presented as a portfolio.
