Occupational Profile

The Furniture, Furnishings and Interiors industry is of significant importance to the UK economy, particularly in the supply of end products for residential and commercial living and workplaces. The ability to work to agreed targets in terms of output and quality standards is essential. Workplaces can be wide - ranging from small workshops to large factories. Furniture Manufacturers must be dexterous, have a good work ethic and able to demonstrate their ability to work individually and as part of a team.

Grading

The standard is graded overall: Fail, Pass or Distinction

End Point Assessment

Knowledge Test

The knowledge test consists of a 60-minute health and safety test and a 40-minute knowledge test on the furniture industry. The health and safety test comprises 45 multiple-choice questions and the industry test comprises 30 multiple-choice questions. The two test scores are combined to give an overall grade for the knowledge component.

Practical Observation

The observation takes place over a maximum 2-hour period and will cover all the skills, knowledge, and behaviours requirements for this assessment method.

Portfolio of Evidence

The portfolio of evidence will show how the apprentice has demonstrated the knowledge, skills and behaviours required to be a competent Furniture Manufacturer.
