## Occupational Profile

Improvement Technicians are responsible for delivery and coaching of improvement activity within an area of responsibility, often associated with Lean and Six Sigma methodologies. They can be found across all industry sectors and functions including automotive, banking, engineering, food products, IT, property, retail, telecoms Local and County Councils, NHS, Voluntary / Charity, Utilities, Pharmaceuticals, Insurance, Hospitality etc.

## Grading

The standard is graded overall: Fail, Pass, Merit or Distinction

## End Point Assessment

### Multiple-Choice Test

The multiple-choice test is an online test consisting of 40 knowledge-based questions. The apprentice will have a maximum of 40 minutes to complete the test.

### Project Report, Presentation & Questioning

The report and presentation are based on an improvement project which clearly shows a business benefit to the apprentice's employer. The presentation will be for a duration of 30-40 minutes with questions and answers for a further 25-35 minutes.

### Professional Discussion underpinned by a Logbook

The professional discussion is a structure discussion between the apprentice and an Independent Assessor. The professional discussion will last for a minimum of 40 minutes to a maximum of 50 minutes.
