Occupational Profile

A quality practitioner deploys deploy effective Quality Practices in their responsible area to ensure organisations fulfil the contractual and regulatory requirements of their customers and other stakeholders. This includes four main elements: 1. Quality Planning, 2. Quality Assurance, 3. Quality Control and 4. Continuous Improvement. In their daily work, an employee in this occupation interacts with a variety of departments within the organisation (engineering, supply chain/procurement, manufacturing, and service delivery departments) and external organisations, such as customers, suppliers and certification bodies when required.

Grading

The standard is graded overall: Fail, Pass or Distinction

Work-Based Project, Presentation and Q&A

The work-based project consists of a 500 summary of the proposed project, a typically 4000-word work-based project report, and a presentation on the work completed with a question-and-answer session. Apprentices must produce a report and deliver a presentation, based on their work-based project. The presentation will be made to an independent assessor. The questioning will be carried out immediately after the presentation.

Professional Discussion underpinned by a Portfolio of Evidence

The professional discussion between the apprentice and independent assessor will last for 60 minutes. It is structured to enable the apprentice to demonstrate their competence and excellence of the KSBs assigned to the professional discussion. The apprentice may use their portfolio of evidence in support of their answers.
