Grading

The standard is graded overall: Fail, Pass or Distinction

Knowledge Test

All knowledge will be assessed in the written knowledge test. The test will consist of 30 multiple-choice questions and last for a maximum of 90 minutes.

Project and Presentation

The 3,000-word workplace project report will assess the apprentice's ability to effectively use the techniques described within the standard. The presentation and Q&A will typically last a minimum of 45 minutes and no more than one hour; the presentation will be for a maximum of 15 minutes.

Professional Dialogue and Interview

The professional dialogue and interview is a structured discussion between the apprentice and an independent assessor covering a range of knowledge, skills, and behaviours. The interview will typically last 30–40 minutes duration.
