Occupational Profile

Warehouse Operatives work in a variety of warehouse environments. Work activities include taking deliveries, checking for damaged/missing items, storing goods, moving stock by various methods, picking/packing orders, loading goods for dispatch, maintaining stock records and documentation, and cleaning. They are required to safely use a range of equipment, machinery, and vehicles, as relevant to their role and setting. This could include mechanical racking systems, materials handling equipment (MHE) or forklift trucks.

Grading

The standard is graded overall: Fail, Pass or Distinction

Knowledge & Behaviours Test

The knowledge & behaviours test is a 1-hour short answer questions and scenario test which tests the apprentice's understanding of all knowledge-based learning outcomes

Practical Assessment (Observation)

The apprentice will be observed in their normal workplace for the duration of 1 hour. Questions may be asked for areas that have not been covered in the observation. The observation is an opportunity for the apprentice to demonstrate all the required skills of their job role.
