Qualification purpose

The OAL Level 3 Award in Behavioural Safety in the Workplace covers the development, implementation and monitoring of behavioural safety programmes. It is for learners working in an organisation with a mature health and safety management system and wishing to implement a behavioural safety programme in the workplace. Consultation with the management and workforce is essential.

Qualification coverage

On achievement of this qualification, learners will be able to implement behavioural safety in the workplace and understand behavioural safety in the workplace.

Qualification Objective

Qualification objectives are supporting a role in the workplace.

Who is this qualification for?

The qualification is aimed at anyone working in an organisation with a mature health and safety management system, wishing to implement a behavioural safety programme in a workplace. Consultation with the management and workforce is essential.

Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for learners selecting this qualification. However, centres must ensure that learners have the potential and opportunity to achieve the qualification successfully. This qualification is not approved for use by learners under the age of 16 years and OAL cannot accept any registrations for learners in this age group.

Assessment methods

This qualification is assessed using the following assessment methods:

- Portfolio of evidence

The portfolio of evidence may consist of various types of assessment evidence including work-based projects, observation of learner performance, question and answer, written records, assignments, projects etc. The portfolio is internally set and marked and Quality Assured by OAL. A portfolio mapping document is available for approved centres to download from the OAL portal.

Learners are required to achieve all learning outcomes and assessment criteria within the seven units of assessment. All assessment criteria must be assessed and achieved by learners.

Knowledge outcomes must be assessed using methods to meet the needs of learners this may include responses to oral or written questioning or the use of assignments or tests.

All assessments are subject to internal quality assurance within approved centres providing this qualification. External quality assurance of assessment and internal quality assurance within approved centres is provided by OAL.

Grading

This qualification is not graded, successful learners will achieve a pass.

Qualification achievement

This qualification is made up of one mandatory unit of assessment. Units are allocated a credit value which provides an indication of the size of the unit in terms of learning hours, 1 credit = 10 learning hours. The units also have assigned Guided Learning Hours (GLH), which indicate the average number of hours a learner may require guidance and support from teaching, learning and assessment professionals to achieve the unit.

The units of assessment set out learning outcomes which describe what learners need to be able to do and understand. The learning outcomes are defined by assessment criteria which

are used to assess competence, expressed as skills achieved and learned knowledge and understanding, to achieve the units. Achievement of the one mandatory unit will mean the qualification has been completed, and will be subject to approval of a claim for certification. OAL will issue a certificate complete with the learner's name, the qualification and unit titles and the credits achieved.
