1. Qualification Specification

1.1. Qualification purpose

This qualification is designed to develop and assess the competent performance of those involved in the assessment of vocational achievement, so they have the necessary skills, knowledge and understanding to work effectively in their role.

On achievement of the qualification practitioners will have developed the competence to perform consistently and reliably, to meet the regulatory requirements of valid assessment in vocational qualifications.

1.2 Qualification Objective

Qualification objective is supporting a role in the workplace.

1.3 Who is this qualification for?

This qualification is designed for Assessors who are involved in the assessment of either workplace competence or related vocational achievement. Assessors include those that assess competence-based or vocationally-related qualifications, and those that carry out the End-point Assessment of Apprenticeship Standards. They work in Awarding Organisation's approved centres often located within colleges, universities, learning providers or businesses, or they work as Independent Apprentice Assessors for Apprentice Assessment Organisations.

To complete this qualification it will be necessary to have a minimum of 2 learners to work with, and these learners must be working in an industry you have occupational knowledge and experience of.

The qualification requirements include planning of assessments, making judgements of performance and knowledge against agreed standards and providing feedback to the learners on performance. The ability to communicate clearly is essential.



1.4 Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for learners selecting this qualification. Organisations providing training and assessment must ensure that learners have the potential and opportunity to achieve the qualification successfully. This qualification is not approved for use by learners under the age of 19 years and OAL cannot accept any registrations for learners in this age group.

1.5 Progression

This qualification will support progression of learners to:

- entry into assessment roles in the learning and skills industry (Assessors)
- level 4 vocational qualifications in education and training
- level 4 vocational qualifications in internal quality assurance of assessment
- increased responsibility in learning and skills management roles

1.10 Qualification achievement

This qualification is a Certificate requiring the achievement of 15 credits, and is made up of three mandatory units of assessment. The units are allocated a credit value which provides an indication of the size of the unit in terms of learning hours, 1 credit = 10 learning hours. The units also have assigned Guided Learning Hours (GLH), which indicate the average number of hours a learner may require guidance and support from teaching, learning and assessment professionals to achieve the unit.

The units of assessment set out Learning Outcomes which describe what learners need to be able to do and understand. The Learning Outcomes are defined by Assessment Criteria which are used to assess competence, expressed as skills achieved and learned knowledge and understanding, to achieve the units. Achievement of the three mandatory units will mean the qualification has been completed, and will be subject to approval of a claim for certification. OAL will issue a certificate complete with the learner's name, the qualification and unit titles and the credits achieved.

Key to unit type

1.12 Assessment

The qualification must be assessed using the following assessment method:

• portfolio of evidence

Learners are required to achieve all learning outcomes within the three units of assessment. Assessment will involve observation of learner performance carrying out assessment activities. To complete this qualification it will be necessary for practitioners to have a minimum of 2 learners to work with, and these learners must be working in an industry/vocational area that the practitioner has occupational knowledge and experience of.

All assessment is subject to internal quality assurance within approved centres providing this qualification.

Externally quality assurance of assessment and internal quality assurance within approved centres is provided by OAL.

This qualification is not graded; achievement certificates for this Award are issued on the basis of awarding a pass only.
