

Qualification title: OAL Level 4 Award in Internal Quality Assurance of Assessment Processes and Practice Qualification number (QN): 601/6681/2

Qualification specification

1.1. Qualification purpose

This qualification is designed to develop and assess the competent performance of Internal Quality Assurers, so they have the necessary skills, knowledge and understanding to work effectively in the quality assurance of assessment of vocational qualifications.

On achievement of the qualification learners will have developed the competence to perform consistently and reliably, to meet the regulatory requirements of valid internal quality assurance of assessment in their work role.

1.2 Qualification Objective

Qualification objective is supporting a role in the workplace.

1.3 Who is this qualification for?

This qualification is designed primarily for Internal Quality Assurers (previously known as Internal Verifiers) who are involved in the quality assurance of vocational assessment processes and practice. They work in Awarding Organisation's approved centres often located within colleges, universities, learning providers or businesses.

1.4 Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for learners selecting this qualification. However, the achievement of a level 3 qualification in assessment practice may be an advantage to some learners. Organisations providing training and assessment for Internal Quality Assurers must ensure that learners have the potential and opportunity to achieve the qualification successfully. This qualification is not approved for use by learners under the age of 19 years and OAL cannot accept any registrations for learners in this age group.

1.5 Progression

This qualification will support progression of learners to:

- Entry into internal quality assurance roles in the learning and skills industry
- Level 4 vocational qualifications in education and training
- Level 4 vocational qualifications in external quality assurance of assessment
- Increased responsibility in learning and skills management roles.

1.7 Qualification coverage

The qualification covers mandatory knowledge in understanding the principles and practices of internally assuring the quality of assessment. It also covers the mandatory skills in internally quality assuring the quality of assessment. This coverage is contained within two mandatory units of assessment to achieve the qualification.

1.10 Qualification achievement

This qualification is an Award requiring the achievement of 12 credits, and is made up of two mandatory units of assessment. The units are allocated a credit value which provides an indication of the size of the unit in terms of learning hours, 1 credit = 10 learning hours. The units also have assigned Guided Learning Hours (GLH), which indicate the average number of hours a learner may require guidance and support from teaching, learning and assessment professionals to achieve the unit.

The units of assessment set out Learning Outcomes which describe what learners need to be able to do and understand. The Learning Outcomes are defined by Assessment Criteria which are used to assess competence, expressed as skills achieved and learned knowledge and understanding, to achieve the units. Achievement of the mandatory units will mean the qualification has been completed, and will be subject to approval of a claim for certification. OAL will issue a certificate complete with the learner's name, the qualification and unit titles and the credits achieved.

Key to unit type

1.12 Assessment

The qualification must be assessed using the following assessment method:



• portfolio of evidence

Learners are required to achieve all learning outcomes within units of assessment. Assessment will involve observation of learner performance carrying out the internal quality assurer's role. All assessment is subject to internal quality assurance within approved centres providing this qualification.

Externally quality assurance of assessment and internal quality assurance within approved centres is provided by OAL. This qualification is not graded; achievement certificates for this Award are issued on the basis of awarding a pass only.
